

Harry "Toot" Edward Foster, 91, of Ericson, Nebraska died February 3, 2013 at the Grand Island Nebraska Veteran's Home.

Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, February 6, 2013 at the United Methodist Church in Ericson, Nebraska. Burial will be in the Bartlett Cemetery. Pastor Delano Cunningham will officiate. He took great pride in his horses; all of which trace back to the first mare he owned 70 years ago.
